#### Uniform Policy

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# **GRADE 6 STUDENTS IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Enclosed please find the letter which indicates that all sixth grade students are required to receive a booster dose of diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis vaccine, (Tdap), as well as one dose of meningococcal (Menactra) vaccine, by the first day of school. Failure to comply with the vaccine requirements means that your child will be **excluded from school on the first day**. Please bring your child's vaccine records on the first day of school.



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
