New Jersey school districts, charter schools, and renaissance school projects are required by statute (N.J.S.A. 18A: 7C-6.6) to annually notify parents or guardians by October 1 of any statewide student assessment or commercially developed standardized assessment that will be administered over the course of the school year. On the next pages, please see the Elizabeth Public Schools' standardized assessment schedule for the 2024-2025 school year.

The state assessments that will be administered by Elizabeth Public Schools during the 2024-2025 school year are the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA), ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS for English Language Learners (ELLs), Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Year End (YE) Model, and New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA).

National assessments administered during 2024-2025 will be the National Assessment for Educational Progress (NAEP) and College Board Assessments, which will include the Preliminary SAT (PSAT10), Preliminary SAT National Merit Scholar Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), SAT, and Advanced Placement (AP) tests in multiple subjects.

The administration of these assessments helps the district to set baseline performance levels for students and monitor and analyze their progress as they advance through their elementary and secondary education. These processes help determine the strengths and weaknesses of each student and inform the development of innovative and personalized learning plans to ensure every child can achieve excellence.
