### **Graduation Requirements Update**



### **Bill A1181/S2054**

- Gov. Murphy signed into law on January 16, 2024
- Requires all graduating high school students (Class of 2025 & beyond) and families to complete either:
  - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or
  - NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application
- Students must submit prior to receiving their high school diploma



### FUTURE EPS INITIATIVES TO SUPPORT FINANCIAL AID COMPLETION

- Increased Financial Aid night for students and families
  - Bi-weekly starting January 2025
- School Level Embedded Financial Aid assistant through our Financial Literacy Curriculum
- Increased partnership with Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) to include:
  - More frequent data sharing
  - Additional professional development for school staff
- Training for student/guardians on the updated graduation requirements including waiver opportunity.

### FAFSA GRADUATION REQUIREMENT WAIVER OPPORTUNITY

A student **shall be exempt from the graduation requirement** if the student or the student's parent or guardian submits to the school district a signed waiver form requesting the exemption from the requirement *and* a form signed by the school counselor authorizing the exemption for good cause as defined by the New Jersey State Board of Education.

### **Digital SAT**

New for 2024, the SAT has gone digital. This includes SAT School Day as well as National Dates on Saturdays.

The digital SAT uses multistage adaptive testing (MST). This means that the digital SAT fairly and accurately measures the same things in a shorter, more secure test while maintaining reliability of the scores

Each assessment has two sections with a 10-minute break between

- Reading and Writing (64 minutes)
- Mathematics (70 minutes)

The following students will be administered the SAT:

- All Grade 11 students in all high schools
- Grade 12 students who do not have SAT scores as per Policy 6146 Graduation Requirements


