



## 19 EPS STUDENTS RECEIVE NATIONAL RECOGNITION PROGRAM HONORS FROM COLLEGE BOARD







Nineteen Elizabeth Public Schools high school students earned academic honors from the College Board National Recognition Program. College Board's National Recognition Programs create pathways to college for students from underserved communities by awarding them academic honors and connecting them with universities across the country. For the first time, the academic honors recognized first-generation students, in addition to rural and small town, Black, Indigenous, and Hispanic/or Latino students. Colleges use these honors to identify students from underrepresented groups who have excelled in classrooms and on College Board assessments such as the PSAT/NMSQT, the PSAT 10, or AP Exams.

## SCHOOL NO. 28 STUDENT WINS ELA HONOR SOCIETY FALL CREATIVE CHALLENGE



Juan Pablo Duarte-José Julián Martí School No 28 student Samantha Moreno was one of three students named a winner of the ELA Honor Society Fall Creative Challenge.

Students in grades six through nine were asked to read and listen to the poetry of Benjamin Zephaniah before writing their own poem, a maximum of 200 words, that is suitable for performance and discusses an issue of social justice the student feels passionate about. Once written, students were then required to record themselves performing their poem.

The poem written by Moreno, along with her video performance, will be published in the ELA Honor Society's November newsletter.




