The Superintendent of Schools recommends approval of the following:

CONTRACT WITH ACE ENDICO

As recommended by Jamie Leavitt, Director of Food and Nutrition Services, that the Elizabeth Board of Education enter into contract with Ace Endico Inc., Brewster, NY, for the purchase of the following category items: Weekly Delivery of Frozen, Fresh, Dry Grocery, Snacks and Cookie Items to various schools and Warehouse in an amount not to exceed \$2,966,254.27, for the 2021-2022 school year, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4a.

Please note: Originally approved at the June 2019 Board Meeting for an amount not to exceed \$2,966,254.27. Contract agreement allows for two additional years (2nd year 2020-2021 and 3rd final year 2021-2022) at the same price, term and conditions.

CONTRACT WITH ACE ENDICO, CORP.

As recommended by Jamie Leavitt, Director of Food and Nutrition Services, that the Elizabeth Board of Education enter into contract with Ace Endico, Corp, Brewster, NY, for the purchase of Processed Commodity Food Items for various schools for Food Services Division, during the 2021-2022 school year, in an amount not to exceed \$284,175.00, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4a.
