There are some things that you will need for school. Please show this letter to your family so they can help you shop for your school supplies during the summer. Look for **<u>BIG</u>** sales during the summer to save money.

The materials this year will not be collected. You will keep your supplies in a plastic container/shoe box. Put your name on all supplies and on the box for sanitary reasons. You will replace your own items as needed.

You will need the following items on the first day of school inside your clear plastic container/shoe box:

- <u>24</u> sharpened <u>Dixon Ticonderoga brand</u> pencils and have a pencil sharpener at home to sharpen your pencils every day (replace pencils when needed)
- <u>2 Large</u> Glue Sticks
- <u>**1**</u> box of 24 crayons (Crayola preferred)
- <u>**1 pack of 10 markers**</u> (basic colors and Crayola preferred)
- <u>1 pair of scissors for children</u>
- <u>1 pack of highlighters</u>
- <u>2 red pens</u>
- <u>1 ruler (to fit in your container)</u>

- <u>1 set of Earbuds for the school computer NOT HEADPHONES they need to fit in</u> your container

These items will be collected for you to use in school:
