Summer Math Practice for Incoming 5th Graders

Dear Students,

As you may or may not know, this coming September, you will be learning math at a 6th grade level in your 5th grade math classroom. In order to brush up on your 5th grade math skills and prepare you for the 6th grade math curriculum, it is important to practice and work to refine your skills during the summer months. You will use the Khan Academy website to gain an advantage and be better prepared for the coming school year. This will allow you extra practice and the opportunity to work at your own pace. Your work should be completed from June through September 13. Below are directions on how to connect to your math teachers through Khan Academy and how to begin. Your math teachers will be monitoring your progress and you will receive credit for your percentage of 5th Grade Course Mastery Completed on Khan Academy in September when you return to school. Please plan to work on your **5th Grade Khan Academy Course Mastery**. You will need to join the 5th Grade Summer class using the directions below. Try to set up a schedule for yourself. (For example: You may choose to work for half an hour on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday). You can access with any device; however, you have your District issued laptop that you have been using. ***You are required to complete 100% of your 5th grade Course Mastery. This will count as a project grade for the 1st marking period. Your grade will reflect the percentage completed out of 100% (For example: In September if you completed 75% of the 5th grade Course Mastery you will receive a 75% as your grade. ***Be sure all multiplication facts are memorized!!!***

Also, we ask that all incoming 5th Grade students practice how to open a combination lock. In 5th grade you will be using lockers that require you to use a combination lock. This becomes a problem when the students do not know how to open a combination lock. My recommendation is to purchase a combination lock over the summer and have the student practice opening it. This will assist greatly in September.

In order to receive credit, you must join our class. Please follow the instructions below.
