## Summer Math Practice for Incoming 4<sup>th</sup> Graders

Dear Students,

As you may or may not know, this coming September, you will be learning math at a 5<sup>th</sup> grade level in your 4<sup>th</sup> grade math classroom. In order to brush up on your 4<sup>th</sup> grade math skills and prepare you for the 5<sup>th</sup> grade math curriculum, it is important to practice and work to refine your skills during the summer months. You will use the Khan Academy website in order to gain an advantage and be better prepared for the coming school year. This will allow you extra practice and the opportunity to work at your own pace. Your work should be completed from June through September 9<sup>th</sup>. Attached are directions on how to connect to Khan Academy and how to begin. (Students of School No. 22 will receive their logins before the end of their 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.) Your math teachers will be monitoring your progress and have already set the 4<sup>th</sup> grade Course Mastery as your Goal for the summer (**This is NOT Get Ready for 4<sup>th</sup> grade**). You will receive credit for the percentage of 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Course Mastery Completed on your return to school. Try to set up a schedule for yourself. (For example: You may choose to work for half an hour on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday or you may want to work for an hour 3 days a week). Khan Academy is a wonderful tool that can be accessed with any device. ***You are required to complete at least 75% of the 4<sup>th</sup> grade Course Mastery (NOT Get Ready for 4<sup>th</sup> grade). Your grade will reflect the percentage completed out of 75% (For example: In September if you completed 75% of the 4<sup>th</sup> grade Course Mastery you will receive a 100% as your grade. Any additional percentage completed will count towards Extra Credit). This will be your project grade for the 1<sup>st</sup> marking period.***

\*\*\*Also, be sure all multiplication facts are memorized!!!

## FOURTH GRADE MATH 2025-2026

### Creating an account for students not having a KHAN account

1. If you already have a KHAN account go directly to **Step #4**.
2. If you do not have a KHAN account go to Sign up at **khanacademy.org**
3. (CLICK ON “CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT”)

4. Visit **khanacademy.org/coaches** (the “Coaches” tab in your profile).

Click on **Join a Class**, enter the class code **WJGN3S5W**

5. Now you’re set. Click on **Subjects** in the upper left side corner.
6. Click on **4<sup>th</sup>** under Math by Grade
7. Click on **Course Mastery. (NOT Get Ready for 4<sup>th</sup> grade)**
8. Go to the **4<sup>th</sup> Grade** on the left side and click **Course Summary**. There you will see all the skills that will need to master. You can begin working on those skills listed below.
9. There are also **Course Mastery Challenges** at the bottom of the list that you can test your knowledge of the skills in this course. If you start with the **Course Challenge**, this can help you understand what you need to Review.
10. Khan Academy will keep a record of the amount of time spent watching math videos and the number of fourth grade math skills mastered and send a report to your **4<sup>th</sup> grade math teacher**. You can check your progress by clicking on **Progress**, then click on **Activity**.
